RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Secure the parts needed to make repairs following proper inventory management procedures
- Perform software updates as needed in various electronic intelligent devices.
- Perform circuit board modifications and updates as per established procedures.
- Remain current with build and test work instructions, Engineering Change Notices, and Quality Alerts to ensure correct / latest instructions are applied to repairs made
- Provide concise repair reports for customers, as well as feedback to appropriate WTC teams to ensure continuous product improvement.
- Work overtime as required.
- Keep workbench and surrounding work area, neat, clean and free from clutter.
- Physical requirements may include prolonged standing, bending, and lifting up to 50 lbs
